

### Description:

There are 14 balls, 7 of each colour, and two aTACit®s. At the centre of the circular board are nine indents, in 3 rows of 3.




### Object of the game:

To win 5 balls from one's opponent.

### Preparation:


This is a game for two players. Each has a set of 7 balls, all of the same colour. Before starting, the balls are placed in the trough as shown. Each player also has one aTACit®.



1. Black starting point
2. White starting point



Each player in turn sends a ball of his own colour around the board, aiming it to land in one of the 9 central indents.

The ball can be sent in either direction, but it must travel at least half way round before coming to rest in an indent.





A player may position his aTACit® anywhere around the rim of the board to deflect the ball into the indents. Remember: the ball must go halfway round the board before hitting the aTACit®.

The first player to form a row of 3 balls of his own colour wins the round, and takes a ball from his opponent, which is placed in the winning player's trough.

A ball that is already in one of the 9 indents may be displaced by a subsequent ball. If it fails to land in another indent, it shall be removed from play until the next round.


The players or player continues to play each round until they have run out of balls.

If all 9 indents are filled and no rows have been formed by either player, the round is replayed.

The first player to win 5 balls from his opponent wins the game.




**Scoring:** Extra ★★

**Double win** – If a player completes two rows of 3 with one shot, he wins two balls from his opponent.



**Fouls** ✖

If a player's ball does not settle in one of the 9 indents, leaves the board, or does not travel more than halfway around the board, that ball is removed from play until the next round.
